

## Pupil Premium Statement – Total for 2018-19: £10,220

Our pupil premium grant for the year 2018 -2019 is £10,220. This will be spent supporting those children to whom it is linked in a number of ways. It helps enable them to fully participate in all the activities the school can offer without the financial burden. One of the main barriers to learning for many of these children is lack of confidence and lack of belief in themselves, therefore we put considerable effort and resources into developing their self-belief. We assess the impact of the spending through Thrive Assessments and Teacher Assessments of their academic performance as well as their social and emotional development. The Pupil Premium Policy is reviewed annually by the Senior Leadership Team.

Most of the Pupil Premium budget is allocated to TLA support for interventions, including our THRIVE programme and the Nurture group. We are delighted with the success of the Nurture group and some funding will go towards materials to develop this area.

Some financial support is given for class visits, residential visits and Forest school work as these are a key part of the curriculum and something that we cannot provide in the classroom. Funding is also given to allow these children to attend after school clubs for which there is a charge.

SENDCo support is provided to monitor progress and support the delivery of the intervention strategies.

Due to the small numbers of pupils in the school who receive funding, the detailed impact cannot be reported due to data protection issues, however the children concerned participated in all activities that were available to them and benefitted tremendously from the THRIVE and Nurture support.
