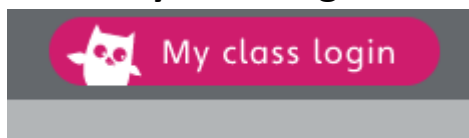


# Oxford Owl Instructions

## 1) Go to oxfordowl.co.uk



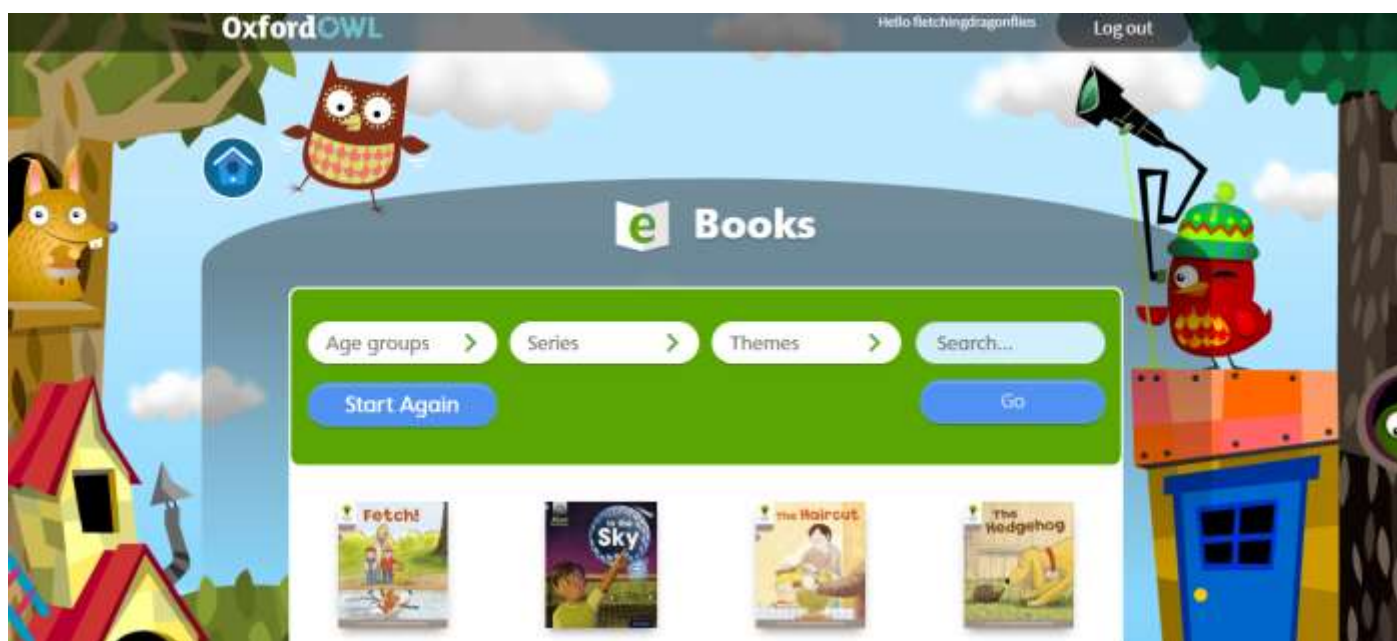
## 2) click “My Class Login”



## 3) Log in with the Username: fletchingdragonflies and Password: fletching



4) This will take you to the homepage.



5) You can then search for books by selecting your age group, series, themes or using key words. **Please note that you can see the book band colours on most of the books. If your book band is not in your age range then please select the older or younger age group to suit you.**

6) Select the e-book you would like to read. You can then turn the pages or listen as an audio book.



7) Some books have support notes for Parents which will may you give you some guidance on how to support your child's comprehension and vocabulary skills.

**Before reading**

**Talk about the book**

- Look at the front and back covers together – these give clues to what the story is about. Flick through the rest of the book before your child reads it.
- Ask some questions such as:
  - What do you think this story might be about?
  - What do you think will happen to the characters in this story?
  - How do you think the friends will 'save the world'?
- Turn to pages 2–3 and recap on the characters' adventures in space so far.

**Challenge words**

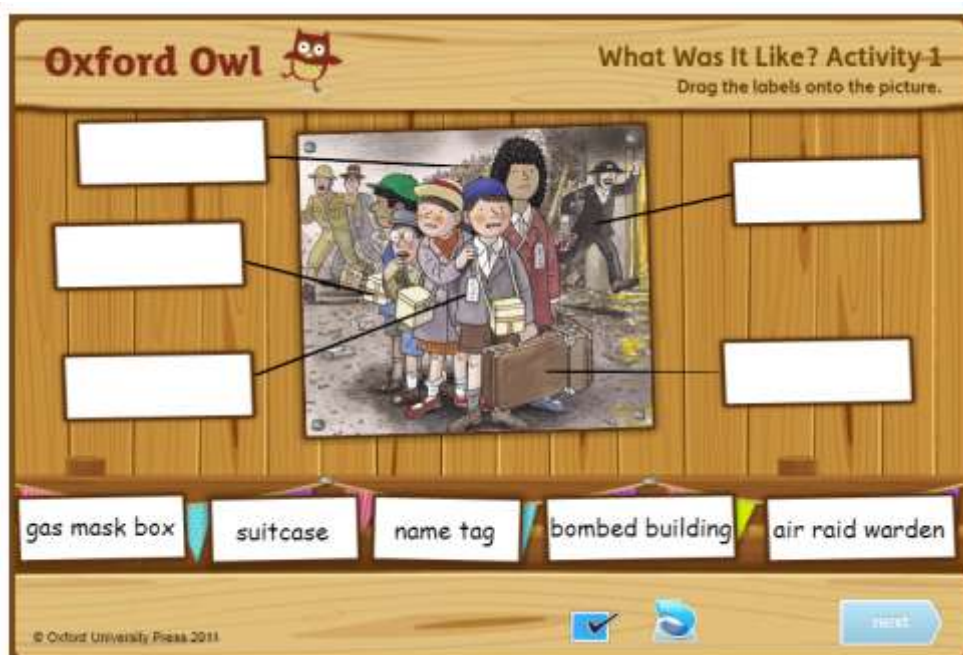



## 9) Some books have a play activity
