	<p><b>Trees 6</b></p> <p>Remember to put all your work from this week into your tree book that you started last week.</p> <p>Watch this video about an oak tree. This is an example of his work.</p>  <p>Using the leaves you collected yesterday and any other natural items you find in your garden or local area make a sculpture.</p> <p>Take a photo of your work in case it rains or is windy tonight!</p>	<p><b>Trees 10</b></p> <p>Lots of artists paint trees and landscapes. Many of Vincent Van Gogh's paintings are of trees and flowers. Here is an example.</p>  <p>You may want to look online for more examples of his tree paintings.</p> <p>Using either paint or coloured pencils can you do a picture of a tree in the style of Van Gogh? Of you may prefer to copy his picture. There is a larger version below.</p>
